COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety can be completed face to face and online, and is the ideal qualification for those considering a career or to improve their position within a work health and safety environment.

This qualification can enhance your existing skills and knowledge by equipping participants with the skillset to contribute more effectively in a workplace environment including aiding the implementation of strategies to control risks and emergency procedures.

COURSE DELIVERY

Complete the BSB41415 Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety:

- As an intensive face to face training course over five days
- Via correspondence
- Online with our engaging Learning Management System CoAssemble at your own pace, over a 12 month time frame

PREREQUISITES AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no formal entry requirements, however, it is preferred that participants display initiative and have some experience in work health and safety environments.

Upon successful completion of this qualification participants may apply for a Work Health and Safety Officer certificate of authority from Workplace Health and Safety Queensland [WHSQ].

COURSE FEES
