COURSE DESCRIPTION

This qualification reflects the role of employees working in supervisory positions in civil construction. They perform tasks involving a broad range of varied activities most of which are complex and non-routine. They are responsible for the quantity and quality of the output of others, contribute to the development of technical solutions to non-routine problems and apply management plans to the workplace.

PREREQUISITES AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no formal entry requirements, however, it is preferred that participants have some experience in the civil construction industry.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Must be engaged or previously engaged to perform work in the building and construction industry for the majority of the person's ordinary hours of work
- Must be an Australian or New Zealand citizen; or permanent resident of Australia; or a refugee and humanitarian visa holder
- Must permanently reside in Queensland; or be permanently employed in Queensland
