COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Generic Induction Coal Surface (GI) program has been developed as part of Gold Training's on-going commitment to the quality of training, education and safety in the coal mining sector.

The GI program is for anyone working in Queensland in the coal mining industry and is also a crucial qualification for those looking to enter the mining industry.

The GI program provides training and assessment for the Resources and Infrastructure Industry (RII) Units of Competency which are specified in Recognised Standard 11, Training in Coal Mines [Qld Coal Mining Safety and Health Act 1999].

The units of competency within this program can be used towards completion of more advanced training courses and qualifications such as RII30115 Certificate III in Surface Extraction Operations.

COURSE OVERVIEW

The GI program (sometimes referred to as 'Standard 11') is a requirement for any worker in the Queensland coal mining industry. This compulsory course is run in accordance with the recognised Standard 11 for training in coal mines.

The purpose for this course is to introduce participants to the following components of the mining industry:

- overview of general mining practices
- Qld coal mining legislation
- risk management
- isolation and tagging procedures
- traffic and mobile equipment procedures
- first aid and emergency procedures, including fire extinguisher training
- accessing and understanding site procedures

PREREQUISITES AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no prerequisites for this program.

COURSE DELIVERY

SKILLS EXPERIENCE LOGBOOK REQUIREMENT

Participants will receive a Skills Experience Logbook which needs to be completed and signed off on site prior to returning the document to Gold Training for sign off and issuance of a Statement of Attainment.

ASSESSMENT

Upon successful completion of the GI program participants will receive:

- a Skills Experience Logbook
- Statement of Completion valid for a period of one year

Upon return of a completed Skills Experience Logbook, each participant that is deemed competent will receive a Statement of Attainment and a GI card from Gold Training, both valid for a period of five years.
